



# GRANTING: DISCRETIONARY FUNDS

## MEETING COMMUNITY NEEDS

The Community Foundation's Distribution Committee meets four times each year to award grants in four fields of interest: education, community development, health, and human services. It's no mystery how hard our local non-profit organizations work for the Community. This year 25 organizations in Grant County received more than \$195,000 in grants as a way to solve many community needs.

## EDUCATION

The **Imagination Library Program** was started in Grant County in 2007 with a grant from the Community Foundation. This year, the Foundation continued its support of this wonderful program with a \$20,984 proactive grant. More than 900 children are currently enrolled in the program, which is available to all Grant County children from birth until age five. Once enrolled, each child receives a brand-new age-appropriate book every month until they turn five, at no cost to the family! Children can sign up at any Grant County library.

Other grants in the Education category were:

- **Van Buren Public Library:** \$3,000 for a new boiler
- **Fairmount Public Library:** \$3,426 for new computers
- **Grant County Superintendents Consortium:** \$11,500 for college cost estimators and FAFSA Days
- **Project Leadership:** \$50,000 for the Project Leadership Program

## COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

The **Indiana Freedom Memorial** is an organization dedicated to honoring and recognizing Grant County's eight fallen soldiers who lost their lives in Operation Iraqi Freedom and Operation Enduring Freedom. The Foundation proudly supported this cause with a \$5,096 grant which will help to build a monument in Matter Park that pays tribute to fallen soldiers.

Other grants in the Community Development category were:

- **Main Street Marion:** \$1,200 for a new website
- **Gas City Area Chamber of Commerce:** \$6,000 for a new website



## HEALTH

**Bridges to Health** is a free health clinic offering primary medical care, dental care, and medication assistance for individuals who do not have health insurance. The clinic opened in 2005 and continues to fill a necessary gap in our health care community. In 2009 a diabetic clinic was added. The Foundation was able to assist Bridges to Health's diabetic clinic with a \$6,900 grant for supplies.

Other grants in the Health category were:

- **Cancer Services of Grant County:** \$1,500 to refurbish their wig room
- **Services for the Visually and Hearing Impaired:** \$5,000 for a new roof



## HUMAN SERVICES

**Grant County Special Olympics** involves individuals of all ages and ability levels, from people with low motor abilities to highly-skilled athletes who can compete in a higher level of sports both in and out of Special Olympics. It is a year-round program that offers a lifetime of learning through sports to more than 200 Grant County athletes. This year, the Foundation helped pay for transportation costs to the Summer Games in Terre Haute with a \$2,100 grant.

Other grants in the Human Services category were:

- **Community Youth Outreach Center:** \$500 for a new sign and paint
- **Marion Grant County Senior Center:** \$27,000 for a new air handling system
- **Grant County Rescue Mission:** \$5,250 for GED testing fees
- **Grant County Sheriff's Department:** \$3,426.50 for an ultra-lite forensic alternate light source kit
- **Grace House for Transition and Recovery:** \$2,247 for a new washer and dryer
- **Carey Services:** \$4,357 for fitness equipment for people with disabilities
- **Family Service Society:** \$4,020 for 40 Developmental Assets
- **Gas City Fire Department:** \$5,000 for a thermal image camera
- **Second Harvest Food Bank:** \$1,240 for the Backpack Program
- **Swayzee Volunteer Fire Department:** \$5,000 for a thermal image camera
- **United Way of Grant County:** \$6,885 for a new copy machine
- **Family Service Society - Hands of Hope:** \$11,550 to support the Flannery Keal Home
- **YMCA -** \$2,117.72 proactive grant to repair the organization's bus

# ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE AWARDS

You don't have to be a sleuth to see that Grant County produces some exceptional graduating seniors as evidenced by the following eleven students who were honored at the Community Foundation's Academic Excellence Awards Program in April. All of this year's recipients received special recognition plaques along with monetary awards.

Two students will receive full, four-year scholarships as the Community Foundation's 2011 Lilly Endowment Community Scholars. They are **RYAN MUGHMAW**, Oak Hill High School, and **DAVID HARVEY**, Marion High School. Ryan and David will receive full tuition to the Indiana colleges of their choice, plus an \$800 stipend for required books and equipment.

Ryan Mughmaw, son of Keith and Lori Mughmaw, ranks first in his class with a 3.99 grade point average and plans to be

a pre-med student at Butler University. David Harvey, son of Dennis and Karen Harvey also ranks first in his class. He plans to study chemical engineering at Rose-Hulman Institute of Technology.

Each Grant County accredited high school is asked to select one representative for the Lilly Endowment Community Scholarship Award. The representatives must have a minimum 3.5 grade point average. Selection criteria include scholastic achievement, attitude, character, desire, and school and community involvement.

Other Lilly finalists included Eastbrook's **ABIGAIL FISHER**, Madison-Grant's **STEPHANIE BROBST**, Mississinewa's **ADDIE BONFITTO**, and The King's Academy's **MADELINE TRUDEAU**. Each of these students will receive a \$1,500 scholarship from the Academic Excellence Fund held within the Foundation.

After the Community Foundation's scholarship selection committee narrows the field of representatives to two nominees and one alternate, the finalists' names are submitted to Independent Colleges of Indiana, Inc. (ICI) for selection of the recipients.

Independent Colleges of Indiana, Inc. is a not-for-profit organization that represents Indiana's independent colleges and universities and one quarter of the state's undergraduate college students.

Other Academic Excellence Award recipients include **LORRIE NEWHOUSE** from Oak Hill, **MATTHEW MCADAMS** and **LUKE HARRIS** from Marion High School, **ALICIA HAZELWOOD** from Madison-Grant, and **ALLISON CORBIN** from Mississinewa High School. Each of these students will receive \$1,000 scholarships from the Community Foundation's Academic Excellence Award Fund.

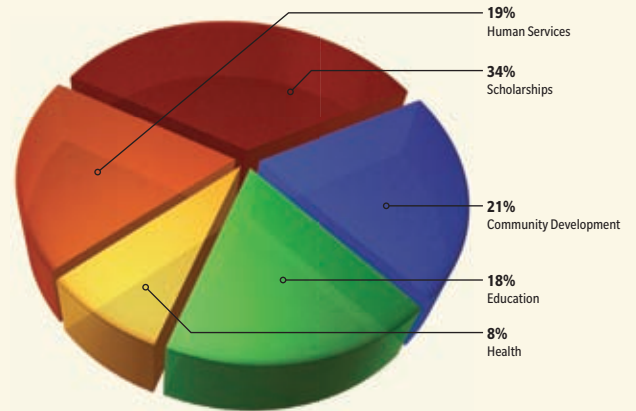

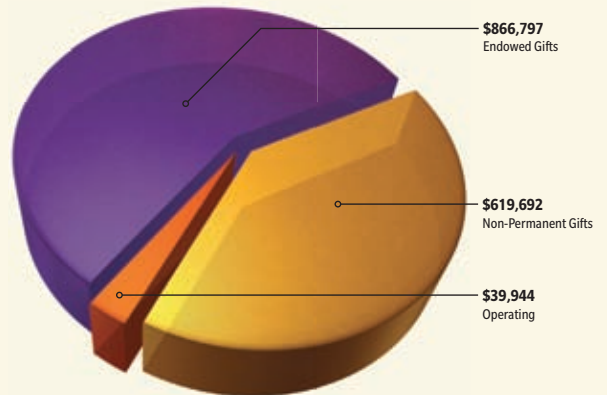
## GRANT DISTRIBUTIONS
