- Larry Myers - Larry chose to allocate his \$5000 to a well-established fund held at the Foundation: The Family Service Society Fund. This fund provides general and program support to all of the many wonderful things Family Services does in our community.

- Lilly Crayton – After much thought, Lilly decided to allocate \$5000 to a scholarship fund for a Grant County graduate pursuing secondary education or trade school. The fund will be named in honor of a very special lady: The NAACP Flossie Bailey Scholarship Fund.
